

AIMS OF THE POLICY

The South Lincolnshire Academies Trust prides itself on high standards of dress as it is firmly believed that the way in which students present themselves in school has a positive effect on their self-esteem, their behaviour and their attitude towards learning. It also impacts on how the wider community views our students.

It is our expectation that students in each of our four schools (Bourne Academy, Spalding Academy, Giles Academy and Cowley Academy) are dressed smartly, safely and appropriately. Each Trust school asks for the co-operation of students and parents/carers in maintaining these standards.

SLAT'S LEGAL DUTIES UNDER THE EQUALITY ACT 2010

The Equality Act 2010 prohibits discrimination against an individual based on protected characteristics, which include sex, race, religion or belief, and gender reassignment.

To avoid discrimination, we will:

- avoid listing uniform items based on sex, to give all students the opportunity to wear the uniform they feel most comfortable in or that most reflects their self-identified gender
- make sure that uniform costs the same for all students
- allow students to wear religious or cultural symbols

LIMITING THE COST OF UNIFORM

As a Trust, we have a duty to ensure uniform that is affordable in line with statutory guidance from the DfE.

SLAT will make sure the uniform:

- is available at a reasonable cost
- provides the best value for money

The Trust will do this by:

- carefully considering items with distinctive characteristics
- limiting the amount of distinctive characteristics
- consider limiting distinctive characteristic items to low-cost or long-lasting items
- avoid specific requirements for items students could wear on non-school days, such as coats, bags and shoes
- keeping the number of optional branded items to a minimum
- avoiding different uniform requirements for different classes, years, houses and extra-curricular activities
- ensuring that second-hand uniform is available to be acquired at the uniform shop
- consulting with all stakeholders on any proposed significant changes to the uniform policy

EXPECTATIONS AND SANCTIONS

Parents and carers are expected to make sure that their child has the correct uniform and sports kit as listed below for each Trust school.

If a student is not conforming to the respective uniform policy:

- they will typically receive a 'strike' on their strike card for any minor infringements (e.g coat on inside) and be required to correct the issue
- communication to parent/carer will be made
- For any major infringement (e.g Haircut or gel nails) they will be required to work in the Student Referral Unit (SRU) or sent home to address the issue

Please note these are not sequential; any may be applied depending on the circumstances. Incidents will be logged using our behaviour management system which will keep a record of any such breach.

The school should be contacted if parents want to request an amendment to the uniform policy in relation to:

- a protected characteristic
- the cost of the uniform
